State Bank of India, Institutional Division, Parliament Street, New Delhi is the only collection bank for the NDF with account No. 11084239799. Donations towards the NDF can be made through cash, cheque, demand draft, money orders and online, through the NDF portal available on its website portion at <a href="https://www.pmindia.nic.in">www.pmindia.nic.in</a>. and through the portal of State Bank of India.

2. In this connection, a reference is invited to this office ID of even number dated 20-8-2014, whereby it was requested to make an arrangement to display the following caption on the home webpage of the Ministry:
